HISTORY

Dr. Malcolm B. Knight served as senior pastor of Southside Baptist Church from 1950-1977. His ministry was characterized by building and missions. Under his leadership the current sanctuary was completed, a new educational building and a link connecting it to the sanctuary were constructed. Interest in planting new churches also grew during his time as pastor and resulted in the establishment of the San Pablo, Lakewood/San Jose, and Holiday Hill Missions, all of which later became self-sustaining churches. Educating future church leaders was very important to Dr. Knight. He served as a Trustee of both Stetson University and Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, and many young people committed their lives to fulltime ministry under Dr. Knight's leadership.

After he retired from Southside, Dr. Knight and his wife Cascile served in several assignments with the Foreign Mission Board (now the International Mission Board) until fully retiring. The Malcolm B. Knight Scholarship was established following his death in 1995, to honor the life and work of this faithful servant of the Lord. In acknowledgment of Cascile's contribution as his partner in life and ministry, it was renamed the Malcolm and Cascile Knight Scholarship following her death in 2010.


AWARDS
